Moreover, the dynamics of interactions helped strengthen relationships among teachers, parents and students. All in all, V-Show received applause from the participating schools and audiences. In view of this, our Board Members have appointed a V-Show Task Force to collaborate with more primary and secondary schools, aiming at integrating this values-based activity into their learning programme. In addition to the above duties, we produce newsletters every quarter and we issue relevant articles from time to time. Our website (www.hkiiel.org.hk) holds a collection of these written works together with a photo album.
